AN ACT REQUIRING STATE EMPLOYEES IN HUMAN SERVICE ROLES TO WORK ON-SITE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (Effective July 1, 2024) On and after July 1, 2024, any 2 commissioner of a state agency that provides human services to 3 individuals in the state may establish an on-site or in-person work policy that requires the employees of such agency to work on-site or in 4 5 person while providing such human services. Such policy may require 6 that such employees work on-site or in person for up to sixty per cent of 7 such employees scheduled work hours. For purposes of this section 8 "human services" has the same meaning as provided in section 17a-750 9 of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
sections:Section 1July 1, 2024New section

Statement of Purpose:

To require state employees who work in human service roles to work on-site under certain circumstances.
