1.5	\$2,500,000 in fiscal year 2019 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.6	of natural resources for a transfer to the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota
1.7	for academic and applied research through MnDRIVE at the Natural Resources Research
1.8	Institute to develop and demonstrate technologies that enhance the long-term viability of
1.9	Minnesota's mining industry. Of this amount: \$1,000,000 is to support continued applied
1.10	research to define and pilot new concepts for sulfate reduction in Minnesota waters; \$500,000
1.11	is for maintenance and expansion of the Natural Resources Atlas to statewide coverage;
