# BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

WHEREAS, Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution 5 provides for the filling of a vacancy in the membership of the House 6 of Representatives by election by the members of the House of 7 Representatives who are affiliated with the same political party as 8 the person last elected to the seat which has become vacant; and 9

WHEREAS, Bob Young of the 32nd House District, has resigned as a 10 member of the House of Representatives of the 135th General Assembly 11 effective October 2, 2023, thus creating a vacancy in the House of 12 Representatives; therefore be it 13

RESOLVED, By the members of the House of Representatives who are 14 affiliated with the Republican party that Jack K. Daniels, Republican, 15 having the qualifications set forth in the Ohio Constitution and the 16 laws of Ohio to be a member of the House of Representatives from the 17 32nd House District, is hereby elected, effective April 24, 2024, 18 pursuant to Section 11 of Article II of the Ohio Constitution, as a 19 member of the House of Representatives from the 32nd House District, 20 to fill the vacancy created by the unexpired portion of the term of 21 said Bob Young ending on December 31, 2024; and be it further 22
