No county or other state agency or political subdivision of this state shall enact or enforce any order, ordinance, or regulation, or perform actions which conflict with, duplicate, or impede the authority provided to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry pursuant to Section A of this act. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023. SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
