## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in limitation of time,
- providing for gender affirmation treatments.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 5540. Gender affirmation treatments.
- 9 (a) Commencement of action. -- If an individual entitled to
- 10 bring a civil action arising from gender affirmation treatment
- 11 <u>is an unemancipated minor at the time the cause of action</u>
- 12 accrues, the period of minority shall not be deemed a portion of
- 13 the time period within which the action must be commenced. The
- 14 individual shall have until attaining 30 years of age to
- 15 commence an action for damages.
- 16 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 17 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 18 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

- 1 "Biological sex." The biological indication of male and
- 2 female in the context of reproductive potential or capacity,
- 3 such as sex chromosomes, naturally occurring sex hormones,
- 4 gonads and nonambiguous internal and external genitalia present
- 5 at birth, without regard to an individual's psychological,
- 6 <u>chosen or subjective experience of gender.</u>
- 7 <u>"Gender." The psychological, behavioral, social and cultural</u>
- 8 <u>aspects of being male or female.</u>
- 9 <u>"Gender affirmation treatment." Includes a medical service</u>
- 10 that seeks to surgically or chemically alter or remove healthy
- 11 physical or anatomical characteristics or features that are
- 12 typical for the individual's biological sex, in order to instill
- 13 or create physiological or anatomical characteristics that
- 14 resemble a sex different from the individual's biological sex,
- 15 <u>including puberty blockade</u>, introduction of cross-sex hormones
- 16 <u>or genital gender reassignment surgery or nongenital gender</u>
- 17 reassignment surgery performed for the purpose of assisting an
- 18 individual with a gender transition.
- 19 "Gender transition." The process in which an individual goes
- 20 from identifying with and living as a gender that corresponds to
- 21 the individual's biological sex to identifying with and living
- 22 as a gender different from the individual's biological sex and
- 23 which may involve social, legal or physical changes.
- 24 "Genital gender reassignment surgery." A genital medical
- 25 procedure performed for the purpose of assisting an individual
- 26 with a gender transition, including any of the following:
- 27 (1) A surgical procedure such as penectomy, orchiectomy,
- 28 vaginoplasty, clitoroplasty or vulvoplasty for biologically
- 29 male patients or hysterectomy or ovariectomy for biologically
- 30 female patients.

- 1 (2) Reconstruction of the fixed part of the urethra with 2 or without a metoidioplasty. (3) Phalloplasty, vaginectomy, scrotoplasty or 3 implantation of erection or testicular prostheses for 4 biologically female patients. 5 6 "Minor." An individual who has not yet attained 18 years of 7 age. "Nongenital gender reassignment surgery." A nongenital 8 medical procedure performed for the purpose of assisting an individual with a gender transition, including any of the 10 following: 11 (1) A surgical procedure for biologically male patients, 12 such as augmentation mammoplasty, facial feminization 13 14 surgery, liposuction, lipofilling, voice surgery, thyroid 15 cartilage reduction, gluteal augmentation, hair
- 17 (2) A surgical procedure for biologically female

reconstruction or various aesthetic procedures.

- patients, such as subcutaneous mastectomy, voice surgery,
- 19 <u>liposuction</u>, <u>lipofilling</u>, <u>pectoral implants or various</u>
- 20 <u>aesthetic procedures.</u>

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
