1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Preventing Child Traf-
- 3 ficking Act of 2024".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 5 In this Act, the term "anti-trafficking recommenda-
- 6 tions" means the recommendations set forth in the report
- 7 of the Government Accountability Office entitled "Child
- 8 Trafficking: Addressing Challenges to Public Awareness
- 9 and Survivor Support", which was published on December
- 10 11, 2023.
- 11 SEC. 3. IMPLEMENTATION OF ANTI-TRAFFICKING PRO-
- 12 GRAMS FOR CHILDREN.
- 13 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 14 date of the enactment of this Act, the Office for Victims
- 15 of Crime of the Department of Justice, in coordination
- 16 with the Office on Trafficking in Persons of the Adminis-
- 17 tration for Children and Families, shall implement the
- 18 anti-trafficking recommendations.
- 19 (b) Report.—Not later than 60 days after the date
- 20 on which the Office for Victims of Crime implements the
- 21 anti-trafficking recommendations pursuant to subsection
- 22 (a), the Director of the Office for Victims of Crime shall
- 23 submit a report to the Committee on the Judiciary of the
- 24 Senate and Committee on the Judiciary of the House of

- 1 Representatives that explicitly describes the steps taken
- 2 by the Office to complete such implementation.
