Abortion facilities; licensure requirements 2 verification; prohibitions; definitions; penalties. 3 4 (a) As used in this article: 5 (i) "Abortion" means б the act of using or prescribing any instrument, medicine, drug or any other 7 8 substance, device or means with the intent to terminate the 9 pregnancy of a woman, including the elimination of one (1) 10 or more unborn babies in a multifetal pregnancy, with 11 knowledge that the termination by those means will, with reasonable likelihood, cause the death of the unborn baby. 12 13 "Abortion" shall not include any use, prescription or means specified in this paragraph if the use, prescription or 14 means are done with the intent to: 15 16 17 (A) Save the life or preserve the health of 18 the unborn baby; 19 20 (B) Remove a dead unborn baby caused by spontaneous abortion or intrauterine fetal demise; 21 22

1 (C) Treat a woman for an ectopic pregnancy; 2 or 3 4 (D) Treat a woman for cancer or another 5 disease that requires medical treatment which treatment may be fatal or harmful to the unborn baby. б 7 8 (ii) "Chemical abortion" means an abortion that is procured, completed or effectuated by means of a drug, 9 10 substance or any combination thereof; 11 12 (iii) "Pregnancy" or "pregnant" means the human female reproductive condition of having a living unborn 13 baby or human being within a human female's body throughout 14 the entire embryonic and fetal stages of the unborn human 15 16 being from fertilization, when a fertilized eqq has 17 implanted in the wall of the uterus, to full gestation and childbirth. 18 19 20 (b) Not less than forty-eight (48) hours before a 21 pregnant woman procures the drugs or substances for a chemical abortion or before a physician or pharmacist 22 dispenses the drugs or substances necessary for a chemical 23 3 HB0137

abortion, whichever is earlier, the pregnant woman shall 1 2 receive an ultrasound in order to provide the pregnant woman the opportunity to view the active ultrasound of the 3 4 unborn child and hear the heartbeat of the unborn child if the heartbeat is audible. 5 б 7 (c) The ultrasound required under subsection (b) of this section shall be of a quality consistent with standard 8 9 medical practice in the community. 10 11 (d) Upon providing an ultrasound under this section, 12 the provider of the ultrasound shall provide the pregnant woman with a document that specifies: 13 14 (i) The date, time and place of the ultrasound; 15 16 17 (ii) The physician who ordered or requested the 18 ultrasound; 19 20 (iii) The physician or technician who performed the ultrasound; 21 22 23 (iv) The age and weight of the unborn child.

(e) Before a physician or pharmacist dispenses the
drugs or substances necessary for a chemical abortion to a
pregnant woman, the physician or pharmacist shall verify
that the ultrasound required by this section occurred.
(f) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection,
any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a

9 felony punishable by a fine not to exceed twenty thousand 10 dollars (\$20,000.00), imprisonment for not more than five 11 (5) years, or both. Nothing in this section shall be 12 construed to subject a pregnant woman to any criminal 13 penalty under this subsection.
