A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act establishing a tax on federal campaign spending in the state; and providing for
- 2 an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 43 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:
- 5 Chapter 62. Federal Campaign Spending Tax.
- Sec. 43.62.010. Levy of federal campaign tax. A tax of five percent is levied on the amount expended in the state for a federal political campaign. In this section,
- 8 (1) "amount expended" includes an amount expended for media, 9 salaries, consultants, and federally reportable expenses;
- 10 (2) "federally reportable expense" means a disbursement or 11 expenditure required to be reported to the Federal Election Commission under 52
- 12 U.S.C. 30104.
- Sec. 43.62.020. Payment of federal campaign tax. The tax levied by

 AS 43.62.010 is due at the time the expenditure is made. A federal political campaign

1	shall collect the tax and remit the tax to the department in accordance with regulations
2	adopted by the department.
3	Sec. 43.62.030. Relationship to municipal taxes. The tax levied by
4	AS 43.62.010 is in addition to any tax imposed by a municipality.
5	* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
