FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to filling a vacancy in the legislature by appointment."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 * **Section 1.** AS 15.40.320 is amended to read:
- 4 Sec. 15.40.320. Condition and time for filling vacancy by appointment.
- When a vacancy occurs in the state legislature, the governor, within 30 days, shall

appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy. However, [IF THE REMAINDER OF

- 7 THE TERM OF THE PREDECESSOR IN OFFICE WILL EXPIRE OR IF A
- 8 VACANCY IN THE STATE SENATE WILL BE FILLED BY A SPECIAL
- 9 ELECTION BEFORE THE LEGISLATURE WILL NEXT MEET, CONVENE, OR
- 10 RECONVENE,] the governor may not fill the vacancy **if**
- 11 (1) the remainder of the term of the predecessor in office will
- 12 <u>expire within 30 days after the vacancy occurs; or</u>
- (2) a vacancy in the state senate will be filled by a special election
- before the legislature will next meet, convene, or reconvene.
