A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing August 10 of each year as Alaska Wild Salmon Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.121. Alaska Wild Salmon Day.** (a) Alaska Wild Salmon Day is
5 established on August 10 of each year to celebrate the enormous bounty that the
6 following wild salmon bring to the state every year:

- 7 (1) chinook, also known as "king";
8 (2) sockeye, also known as "red";
9 (3) coho, also known as "silver";
10 (4) chum, also known as "dog" or "keta"; and
11 (5) pink, also known as "humpy."

12 (b) Alaska Wild Salmon Day may be observed by educational and celebratory
13 events, projects, and activities.
