FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to sexual abuse and sexual assault awareness and prevention efforts in
- 2 public schools."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
- 5 to read:
- 6 SHORT TITLE. This Act may be known as Erin's Law.
- * Sec. 2. AS 14.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- 8 Article 6A. Sexual Abuse and Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention.
- 9 Sec. 14.30.355. Sexual abuse and sexual assault awareness and prevention.
- 10 (a) The governing body of each school district shall adopt and implement a policy,
- establish a mandatory training program for employees and students, and provide
- parent, student, and staff notices relating to sexual abuse and sexual assault awareness
- and prevention for students enrolled in grades kindergarten through 12.
- 14 (b) The policy, training, and notices under this section must include

1	(1) age-appropriate information;
2	(2) warning signs of sexual abuse of a child;
3	(3) referral and resource information;
4	(4) available student counseling and educational support;
5	(5) methods for increasing teacher, student, and parent awareness of
6	issues regarding sexual abuse of children;
7	(6) actions that a child may take to prevent and report sexual abuse or
8	sexual assault.
9	(c) In this section, "school district" has the meaning given in AS 14.30.350.
