1 "An Act establishing May 15 each year as Think Local Day; and providing for an

2 effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

5 Sec. 44.12.132. Think Local Day. Think Local Day is established on May 15 6 each year to support local businesses and local products and to recognize the economic 7 and social benefits that local businesses and local products provide to communities 8 throughout the state. Think Local Day may be observed by celebratory events, 9 projects, and activities directed at or involving people of all ages to increase their 10 awareness and use of local businesses, food, and products.

11 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
