3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- *** Section 1.** AS 08.01.065(c) is amended to read:
 - (c) Except as provided in (f) (h) [(f) (k)] of this section, the department shall establish fee levels under (a) of this section so that the total amount of fees collected for an occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. The department shall annually review each fee level to determine whether the regulatory costs of each occupation are approximately equal to fee collections related to that occupation. If the review indicates that an occupation's fee collections and regulatory costs are not approximately equal, the department shall calculate fee adjustments and adopt regulations under (a) of this section to implement the adjustments. In January of each year, the department shall report on all fee levels and revisions for the previous year under this subsection to the office of management and

1	budget. If a board regulates an occupation covered by this chapter, the department
2	shall consider the board's recommendations concerning the occupation's fee levels and
3	regulatory costs before revising fee schedules to comply with this subsection. In this
4	subsection, "regulatory costs" means costs of the department that are attributable to
5	regulation of an occupation plus
6	(1) all expenses of the board that regulates the occupation if the board
7	regulates only one occupation;
8	(2) the expenses of a board that are attributable to the occupation if the
9	board regulates more than one occupation.

15	regulatory cost of an occupation and income levels in that occupation.

28	Upon issuance of an endorsement, the department shall also issue to the person
29	receiving the endorsement notice of the penalties that may be imposed under this
