FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to disclosure of information by nonprofit corporations."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

3	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
4	to read:
5	SHORT TITLE. This Act may be known as the Charity Protection Act.
6	* Sec. 2. AS 10.20.151(b) is amended to read:
7	(b) It is not necessary to set out in the articles of incorporation any of the
8	corporate powers enumerated in this chapter or any protected information. In this
9	subsection, "protected information" has the meaning given in AS 10.20.625(b).
10	* Sec. 3. AS 10.20.251 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
11	(b) It is not necessary to set out in the articles of merger or consolidation any
12	protected information. In this subsection, "protected information" has the meaning
13	given in AS 10.20.625(b).
14	* Sec. 4. AS 10.20.625 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
15	(b) The commissioner may not require a domestic corporation or foreign

corporation to disclose protected information in the biennial report or any other
document. In this subsection, "protected information" includes a list, record, register,
registry, roll, roster, or other compilation of data that directly or indirectly identifies a
person as a donor of financial or nonfinancial support to a nonprofit organization.
