- 1 "An Act relating to occupational licensing fees; relating to business license fees; and
- 2 providing for an effective date."

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3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- *** Section 1.** AS 08.01.065(a) is amended to read:
- 5 (a) Except for business licenses, the department shall adopt regulations that
 6 establish the amount and manner of payment of application fees, examination fees,
 7 license fees, registration fees, permit fees, [INVESTIGATION FEES,] and all other
 8 fees as appropriate for the occupations covered by this chapter.

- 10 (c) Except as provided in (f) (k) of this section, the department shall establish 11 fee levels under (a) of this section so that the total amount of fees collected for an 12 occupation approximately equals the actual regulatory costs for the occupation. 1	occupation. If the review indicates that an occupation's fee collections and regulatory
