**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to arson in the third degree."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 \* **Section 1.** AS 11.46.420(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A person commits the crime of arson in the third degree if the person  
5 intentionally damages a motor vehicle

6 (1) by starting a fire or causing an explosion while that vehicle is  
7 located on **public** [STATE OR MUNICIPAL] land; **or**

8 (2) **that is the property of another person by starting a fire or**  
9 **causing an explosion while that vehicle is located on private property.**

10 \* **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 APPLICABILITY. AS 11.46.420(a), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, applies to  
13 offenses committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
