FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to airport security screening pat-down searches."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* **Section 1.** AS 02.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 02.15.235. Witness present during security screening pat-down search. A person who is subject to an airport security screening private pat-down search may request that a witness of the person's choosing be present at the private pat-down search. The witness may be a police officer employed by the state or a political subdivision of the state. The security screening personnel may not refuse the request for a witness to be present at a private pat-down search.
