FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to Alaska marine highway system ports."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 19.65 is amended by adding a new section to article 1 to read:

4 **Sec. 19.65.040. Ports.** The Alaska marine highway system shall maintain
5 service to ports located in

6 (1) Bellingham, Washington;

7 (2) Prince Rupert, British Columbia;

8 (3) southeast Alaska, including Angoon, Gustavus, Haines, Hoonah,
9 Juneau, Kake, Ketchikan, Metlakatla, Pelican, Petersburg, Sitka, Skagway, Tenakee,
10 Wrangell, and Yakutat;

11 (4) southcentral Alaska, including Chenega Bay, Cordova, Homer,
12 Seldovia, Tatitlek, Valdez, and Whittier;

13 (5) southwest Alaska, including Akutan, Chignik, Cold Bay, False
14 Pass, King Cove, Kodiak, Old Harbor, Ouzinkie, Port Lions, Sand Point, and Dutch
15 Harbor.
