1 "An Act relating to Alaska marine highway system ports."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 19.65 is amended by adding a new section to article 1 to read:
- Sec. 19.65.040. Ports. The Alaska marine highway system shall maintain
- 5 service to ports located in
- 6 (1) Bellingham, Washington;
- 7 (2) Prince Rupert, British Columbia;
- 8 (3) southeast Alaska, including Angoon, Gustavus, Haines, Hoonah,
- 9 Juneau, Kake, Ketchikan, Metlakatla, Pelican, Petersburg, Sitka, Skagway, Tenakee,
- Wrangell, and Yakutat;
- 11 (4) southcentral Alaska, including Chenega Bay, Cordova, Homer,
- 12 Seldovia, Tatitlek, Valdez, and Whittier;
- 13 (5) southwest Alaska, including Akutan, Chignik, Cold Bay, False
- Pass, King Cove, Kodiak, Old Harbor, Ouzinkie, Port Lions, Sand Point, and Dutch
- Harbor.
