### A BILL

# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to a tax credit for certain oil and gas equipment in the Cook Inlet
- 2 sedimentary basin; repealing certain credits against the oil and gas production tax; and
- 3 providing for an effective date."

#### 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 43.98 is amended by adding a new section to read:

### 6 Article 5. Oil and Gas Tax Credit Certificates.

- Sec. 43.98.080. Tax credit for jack-up rigs. (a) The department shall provide
  a tax credit certificate to a person who, after the effective date of this Act and before
  July 1, 2030, installs a jack-up rig in the Cook Inlet sedimentary basin. To receive a
  credit under this section the jack-up rig must be used, or contracted to be used, in the
  Cook Inlet sedimentary basin for at least three years. The tax credit is equal to the
  lesser of
- 13 (1) the total cost of purchasing or leasing the jack-up rig and 14 transporting the jack-up rig to the Cook Inlet sedimentary basin; or

1	(2) \$75,000,000.
2	(b) A person who receives a tax credit certificate under (a) of this section may
3	use the credit, or a portion of the credit, to offset taxes imposed under this title. Any
4	unused portion of the credit may be carried forward to a subsequent tax year.
5	(c) A tax credit certificate issued under (a) of this section may not
6	(1) be sold, assigned, exchanged, conveyed, or otherwise transferred,
7	in whole or in part;
8	(2) be applied to reduce a person's tax liability under this title to below
9	zero; or
10	(3) be the basis for a credit under another provision of this title.
11	(d) In this section, "jack-up rig" means a mobile drilling platform with
12	extendible legs for support on the ocean floor.
13	* Sec. 2. AS 43.55.025(a)(5) and 43.55.025( <i>l</i> ) are repealed.
14	* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
