# A RESOLUTION

# 1 Authorizing the House of Representatives and the Senate to recess for a period of more

2 than three days.

## **3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

WHEREAS art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither house of the legislature may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and

WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that
adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house
constitutes concurrence;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate and the House of
 Representatives may each recess for more than three days, but for not more than seven days,
 during the Second Special Session of the Thirty-First Alaska State Legislature; and be it

# FURTHER RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the finance committees of each house may meet in Anchorage during a recess of both houses of the legislature.
