## **A RESOLUTION**

- 1 Proposing amendments to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to terms of

## 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* **Section 1.** Article II, sec. 3, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:
- Section 3. Election and Terms. Legislators shall be elected at general elections. Their terms begin on the fourth Monday of the January following election unless otherwise provided by law. The term of representatives shall be two years, and the term of senators, four years. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two years. No person who has served as a representative for six full or partial successive terms shall again be eligible to hold that office. No person who has
- served as a senator for three full or partial successive terms shall again be eligible
- 12 **to hold that office.**
- \* Sec. 2. Article XV, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Section 30. Application of 2022 Tenure Amendment. Years served in the legislature before the convening of the First Regular Session of the Thirty-Third Alaska

- State Legislature shall not be considered for purposes of applying the tenure limit added by the 2022 amendment to Section 3 of Article II.
- \* Sec. 3. The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws of the state.
