A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the taking of antlerless moose; and providing for an effective date."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 16.05.780(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) The taking of antlerless moose in any game management unit or subunit or
5 a portion of a unit or subunit is prohibited except **as authorized by emergency order**
6 **under AS 16.05.060** [THAT ANTLERLESS MOOSE MAY BE TAKEN ONLY
7 UNDER REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER (b) OF THIS SECTION AFTER

8 (1) THE DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDS THE SEASON BE
9 OPENED IN THAT YEAR, BASED ON BIOLOGICAL EVIDENCE, AND

10 (2) A MAJORITY OF ACTIVE LOCAL ADVISORY
11 COMMITTEES FOR THAT UNIT OR SUBUNIT HAVE RECOMMENDED AN
12 OPENING FOR THAT YEAR, AFTER EACH HAS TAKEN A VOTE AND A
13 MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THOSE COMMITTEES HAVE VOTED IN
14 THE AFFIRMATIVE].

15 * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.780(b) is repealed.

1 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
