# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to fireworks; repealing restrictions on the sale of fireworks; directing
- 2 the Department of Public Safety to adopt fireworks regulations; and providing for an
- 3 effective date."

### 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 5 \* **Section 1.** AS 11.81.900(b)(24) is amended to read:
- 6 (24) "explosive" means a chemical compound, mixture, or device that
  7 is commonly used or intended for the purpose of producing a chemical reaction
  8 resulting in a substantially instantaneous release of gas and heat, including dynamite,
  9 blasting powder, nitroglycerin, blasting caps, and nitrojelly, but excluding salable
  10 fireworks as defined in <u>regulation</u> [AS 18.72.100], black powder, smokeless powder,
- small arms ammunition, and small arms ammunition primers;

- Sec. 18.72.010. Regulation of fireworks. (a) The Department of Public Safety shall adopt regulations for the purpose of protecting life and property from fire

1	and explosion by establishing minimum standards for fireworks, including sale,
2	storage, distribution, and use.
3	(b) The commissioner of public safety may establish by regulation, and the
4	Department of Public Safety may charge, reasonable fees for fireworks permits and
5	inspections.
6	(c) During reasonable business hours, the Department of Public Safety may,
7	for the sole purpose of inspecting fireworks for compliance with regulations adopted
8	under this section, enter any building where fireworks are stored or kept.

10	Sec. 18.72.040. Criminal penalty. A person who recklessly fails to comply
11	with [A PROVISION OF THIS CHAPTER OR] fireworks regulations adopted under
12	AS 18.72.010 [IN THE FIRE SAFETY CODE] is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
13	Each day of noncompliance constitutes a separate offense. In this section, "recklessly"
14	has the meaning given in AS 11.81.900.

16	Sec. 18.72.060. Municipal regulation of fireworks. Fireworks [THIS
17	CHAPTER AND FIREWORKS] regulations adopted under AS 18.72.010 [THE FIRE
18	SAFETY CODE] supersede the provisions of an ordinance adopted by a city or
19	borough, whether before or after May 23, 1969, that are less restrictive than [THIS
20	CHAPTER OR] the <u>regulations</u> [CODE]. However, nothing in this section affects the
