3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 28.15.055 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 - (b) A person holding a provisional driver's license shall display in the rear window of each vehicle operated by the person a moveable sticker issued by the department that identifies that the vehicle is operated by a provisional licensee. The department may charge a fee for the issuance of a sticker. Failure to display a sticker as required by this subsection is an infraction and may be punished by a fine of not more than \$200. However, a person charged with violating this section may not be convicted if the person
- 12 (1) has not previously been arrested, charged, or cited for a violation of 13 this section; and
- 14 (2) produces in court proof that the person has obtained and displayed

- 1 the sticker required by this subsection.
- 2 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2013.
