A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to certain game seized by the state and unlawfully taken game."

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* **Section 1.** AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 16.05.197. Compensation for certain seized game. If the state or an agent of the state seizes a bear, bison, caribou, deer, elk, goat, moose, sheep, or musk ox from the individual who harvested the animal for a suspected violation of statute or a regulation of the department and the individual is later found not guilty of violating the statute or regulation or if the individual is convicted and the conviction is overturned on appeal or otherwise set aside, the state shall provide monetary compensation to the individual in the amount a court is permitted to order a person to pay in restitution for unlawfully taking the same species under AS 16.05.925(b).

- * **Sec. 2.** AS 16.05.925(b) is amended to read:
- (b) In addition to a penalty imposed under (a) of this section or any other penalty for violation of this title or a regulation adopted under this title, a person who is convicted of unlawfully taking an animal listed in this subsection may be ordered by

2	animal unlawfully taken:
3	(1) Bear, black
4	(2) Bear, brown or grizzly
5	(3) Bison
6	(4) Caribou
7	(5) Deer

14	(12) Wolverine
