**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act establishing an executive secretary position for the Board of Public**  
2 **Accountancy."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 08.04 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 08.04.055. Executive secretary of board.** (a) The department, in  
6 consultation with the board, shall employ a certified public accountant or person who  
7 has other accounting experience satisfactory to the board and who is not a member of  
8 the board to serve as executive secretary of the board.

9 (b) The executive secretary shall perform duties as prescribed by the board.

10 **\* Sec. 2.** AS 08.04.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

11 (h) The board shall define by regulation the qualifications and duties of the  
12 executive secretary and delegate authority to the executive secretary as necessary to  
13 conduct board business.
