24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

25 Section 1. Act 2011-535, HB56, of the 2011 Regular
26 Session, now appearing as Chapter 13 of Title 31, Code of

1 Alabama 1975, the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen
2 Protection Act, is repealed.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
