17 TO BE ENTITLED
18 AN ACT

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20 Relating to health insurance; to require the State
21 Employees' Insurance Board (SEIB) and the Public Education
22 Employees' Health Insurance Board to submit reports on the
23 number of employees and their dependents enrolled in the State
24 Employees' Health Insurance Plan and the Public Education
25 Employees' Health Insurance Plan (PEEHIP); and to provide for
26 reporting dates.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Commencing on the second legislative day
2 of the 2014 Regular Session, the State Employees' Insurance
3 Board shall submit to the Lieutenant Governor, the President
4 Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of
5 Representatives a report of how many employees and their
6 dependents are enrolled in the State Employees' Health
7 Insurance Plan as follows:

8 (1) 2014 Regular Session for the years 2006 to 2013,
9 inclusive.

10 (2) 2015 Regular Session for the year 2014.

11 (3) 2016 Regular Session for the year 2015.

12 (4) 2017 Regular Session for the year 2016.

13 (5) 2018 Regular Session for the year 2017.

14 (6) 2019 Regular Session for the year 2018.

15 Section 2. Commencing on the second legislative day
16 of the 2014 Regular Session, the Public Education Employees'
17 Health Insurance Board shall submit to the Lieutenant
18 Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the
19 Speaker of the House of Representatives a report of how many
20 employees and their dependents are enrolled in the Public
21 Education Employees' Health Insurance Plan as follows:

22 (1) 2014 Regular Session for the years 2006 to 2013,
23 inclusive.

24 (2) 2015 Regular Session for the year 2014.

25 (3) 2016 Regular Session for the year 2015.

26 (4) 2017 Regular Session for the year 2016.

27 (5) 2018 Regular Session for the year 2017.

1 (6) 2019 Regular Session for the year 2018.

2 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
3 first day of the third month following its passage and
4 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
