4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, a voter in Alabama may vote
6	only on election day unless he or she has an excuse to
7	vote by absentee ballot.
8	This bill would require each county to provide
9	at least one early voting center to be open during the
10	week immediately preceding election day, which would
11	allow registered voters to vote prior to election day.
12	This bill would prescribe the hours of operation
13	for each early voting center.
14	This bill would clarify that this act does not
15	impair or affect the powers and duties of boards of
16	registrars, judges of probate, and other election
17	officials.
18	This bill would also require the Secretary of
19	State to adopt rules.

27	provide at least one early voting center to be open during the

29 voters to vote prior to election day; to prescribe the hours 30 of operation for each early voting center; and to clarify that 31 this act does not impair or affect the powers and duties of 32 boards of registrars, judges of probate, and other election 33 officials.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 34

35 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "early voting 36 center" means a location where registered voters may vote not 37 less than four days nor more than six days during the one-week period immediately preceding election day. 38

39 (b) The governing body of each county shall designate and provide at least one early voting center. If a governing 40 body designates more than one, the governing body shall have 41 42 the sole authority to configure boundaries for each early 43 voting center in the county. The governing body shall 44 determine the days an early voting center may be open for 45 early voting; provided, however, an early voting center shall 46 be open not less than four days nor more than six days during 47 the one-week period immediately preceding election day. Hours 48 of operation for each early voting center shall be as follows:

49 (1) On weekdays and Saturdays, early voting centers shall be open 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. 50

51 (2) On Sundays, early voting centers shall be open 1:00 52 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

53 (c) Any registered voter may vote in the appropriate 54 early voting center located in his or her county.

(d) Nothing in this section shall impair or affect the 55 56 powers and duties of boards of registrars, judges of probate,

57 and other election officials under Title 17, Code of Alabama 58 1975, nor shall it affect the procedures and requirements for 59 election day voting.

60 (e) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules for the 61 implementation and administration of this section.

62 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October 63 1, 2024.
