4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, the Commissioner of the
6	Department of Conservation and Natural Resources may
7	introduce desirable species of game fish into the
8	waters of this state.
9	This bill would require the commissioner to
10	issue a permit to municipalities and private entities
11	to release black bass into the Coosa River provided
12	certain requirements are satisfied.

18	Relating to natural resources; to require the
19	Commissioner of the Department of Conservation and Natural
20	Resources to issue a permit for the introduction of black bass
21	into the Coosa River when certain requirements are satisfied.
22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. (a) The Commissioner of the Department of
24	Conservation and Natural Resources shall issue a permit to a
25	municipality or private entity associated with fishing or
26	conservation that allows the introduction and placement of
27	black bass into the Coosa River if all of the following are
28	satisfied:

## HB15 INTRODUCED



(1) The municipality or private entity obtains the
black bass from a fish hatchery located in this state which is
approved by the department.

(2) The only black bass that will be introduced or
placed into the Coosa River are the Northern Largemouth Bass
(Micropterus salmoides salmoides) subspecies, the Florida Bass
(Micropterus salmoides floridanus) subspecies, or a first
generation offspring of these two subspecies.

37 (3) The municipality or private entity bears all costs
38 associated with the purchase, transport, and introduction of
39 the black bass.

(b) The commissioner, under his or her authority
granted in Sections 9-2-2 and 9-2-7, Code of Alabama 1975, may
deny a permit as provided for in this section due to
environmental, pathogenic, or biological factors or for the
protection of public health and welfare.

(c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit the commissioner from issuing permits for the introduction and placement of other subspecies of black bass into segments of the Coosa River when the commissioner determines that the introduction and placement of those subspecies is appropriate for the fishery.

51 (d) The Department of Conservation and Natural
52 Resources shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this
53 section.

54 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1, 2024.
