8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental appropriation  
9 from the State General Fund to the Department of  
10 Corrections in the amount of \$30,000,000 for the  
11 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018; makes a  
12 supplemental appropriation from the State General  
13 Fund to the Departmental Emergency Fund in the  
14 amount of \$2,500,000 for the fiscal year ending  
15 September 30, 2018; and makes a supplemental  
16 appropriation from the DNA Fund to the Department  
17 of Forensic Sciences in the amount of \$500,000 for  
18 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018.

24 To make a supplemental appropriation from the State  
25 General Fund to the Department of Corrections in the amount of  
26 \$30,000,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018; to  
27 make a supplemental appropriation from the State General Fund

1 to the Departmental Emergency Fund in the amount of \$2,500,000  
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018; and to make a  
3 supplemental appropriation from the DNA Fund to the Department  
4 of Forensic Sciences in the amount of \$500,000 for the fiscal  
5 year ending September 30, 2018.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations  
8 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
9 \$30,000,000 from the State General Fund to the Department of  
10 Corrections for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018.

11 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations  
12 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
13 \$2,500,000 from the State General Fund to the Departmental  
14 Emergency Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018.

15 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations  
16 heretofore or hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated  
17 \$500,000 from the DNA Fund to the Department of Forensic  
18 Sciences for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018.

19 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
20 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
21 upon its otherwise becoming law.
