8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are
9 established for enumerated state agencies. The
10 agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama
11 Sunset Committee. After the review process is
12 completed, the committee prepares its
13 recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature
14 in the form of sunset bills which either continue,
15 terminate, or continue with modification each
16 agency reviewed.

17 This bill would provide for the continuance
18 of the Alabama Security Regulatory Board until
19 October 1, 2019, with the following changes: To
20 clarify the authority of the board to establish
21 fees relating to the licensure of certified
22 trainers.

1 Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the
2 existence and functioning of the Alabama Security Regulatory
3 Board until October 1, 2019, with certain modifications; to
4 amend Section 34-27C-9, Code of Alabama 1975, so as to clarify
5 the authority of the board to establish fees relating to the
6 licensure of certified trainers.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
9 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama
10 Security Regulatory Board until October 1, 2019, with the
11 additional recommendation for statutory change as set out in
12 Section 3.

13 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the
14 Alabama Security Regulatory Board, created and functioning
15 pursuant to Sections 34-27C-1 to 34-27C-18, inclusive, Code of
16 Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1, 2019, and those
17 code sections are expressly preserved.

18 Section 3. Section 34-27C-9 of the Code of Alabama
19 1975, is amended to read as follows:

20 "§34-27C-9.

21 "Any person conducting training of security officers
22 shall be licensed as a certified ~~as a~~ trainer by the board.
23 Any person seeking ~~certification~~ licensure as a certified
24 trainer shall pay all fees required by the board and meet all
25 of the following qualifications:

26 "(1) Be 21 years of age or older.

1 "(2) Have a minimum of two years of supervisory
2 experience with a contract security company, a proprietary
3 company, or in federal, state, county, or municipal law
4 enforcement.

5 "(3) Have a minimum of one year of experience in
6 teaching security-related courses or have attended a board
7 approved two-week instructor's course.

8 "(4) Submit proof of compliance with all instruction
9 and training requirements established by the board."

10 Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
11 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
12 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

13 Section 5. This act shall become effective
14 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or
15 its otherwise becoming law.
