- 9 Section 1. Any municipality within Houston County may
- 10 contract for police services with the sheriff of the county.
- 11 The contract may include the enforcement by the sheriff and
- 12 his or her duly commissioned deputies of all laws within the
- corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the municipality,
- 14 including municipal ordinances, and the arrest or citation of
- any offenders as if the sheriff and his or her deputies were
- 16 duly constituted police officers of the municipality.
- 17 Section 2. A municipality entering into a contract with
- 18 the sheriff for police services shall pay to the county
