Enrolled, An Act,

A BILL  
TO BE ENACTED  
AN ACT

Relating to municipalities and counties; to require all motor fuel taxes levied by municipalities and counties after the effective date of this act to be used only for road and bridge purposes with certain exceptions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Except for those taxes on motor fuels that are levied or that may be levied by a county or municipality pursuant to a local law or general law of local application that is in effect on the effective date of this act, all taxes on motor fuels, as defined in Section 40-17-322, Code of Alabama 1975, whether called an excise tax, license tax, or otherwise, levied by a municipality or county after the effective date of this act may be used only for the cost of administering the tax, cost of construction, reconstruction, maintenance, mass transit, and repair of roads, bridges, and rights-of-ways, cost of traffic regulation, and the cost of enforcing traffic and motor vehicle laws.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first
