1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to extradition; to amend Section 15-9-62, Code  
4 of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the mileage and daily  
5 fees paid to an agent of the state in certain circumstances;  
6 and to make nonsubstantive, technical revisions to update the  
7 existing code language to current style.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 15-9-62, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "§15-9-62

12 (a) Expenses incurred in transporting an accused  
13 individual shall be paid as follows:

14 (1) When the ~~punishment of the individual is accused of~~  
15 a crime punishable by ~~shall be the confinement of the criminal~~  
16 ~~in the penitentiary with the Department of Corrections or~~  
17 death, the expenses ~~incurred in bringing an accused back to~~  
18 ~~the State of Alabama~~ shall be paid out of the State Treasury,  
19 on the certificate of the Governor and warrant of the  
20 Comptroller.

21 (2) In all other cases, ~~they~~ the expenses shall be paid  
22 out of the county treasury in the county ~~wherein~~ in which the  
23 crime is alleged to have been committed.

24 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law  
25 regulating expenses of state officers and employees, the  
26 sheriff or other agent of the state shall receive all of the  
27 following:

28 (1) ~~\$8.00~~ One hundred dollars (\$100) per day while

29 going to and returning from the place where the prisoner is  
30 arrested or confined ~~and.~~

31 (2) actual ~~Actual~~ necessary expenses, ~~including~~  
32 ~~expenses of transportation;.~~

33 (3) For transportation, ~~if train or bus is used,~~ actual  
34 ~~cost of transportation shall be allowed, but if the trip is~~  
35 ~~made in the personal car of the sheriff or other agent of the~~  
36 ~~state there shall be allowed for transportation \$.10 for each~~  
37 ~~mile traveled~~ the agent shall be reimbursed as provided under  
38 Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 36.

39 (c) Any expenses incurred by an agent of another state  
40 may also be paid pursuant to subsection (a) ~~There shall also be~~  
41 ~~allowed the fees paid to the officers of the state on whose~~  
42 ~~Governor the requisition is made."~~

43 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October  
44 1, 2024.
