## HB272 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Talladega County; providing for additional  
3 expense allowance and salary for the coroner.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. Commencing for the first month after the  
6 effective date of this act, the Coroner of Talladega County  
7 shall receive an additional expense allowance in the amount of  
8 eight thousand dollars (\$8,000) per year, which shall be in  
9 addition to all other expense allowances, compensation, or  
10 salary provided by law. This expense allowance shall be  
11 payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund of  
12 the county each month.

13 Section 2. Beginning with the expiration of the term of  
14 the incumbent Coroner of Talladega County, the annual salary  
15 for the Coroner shall be twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per  
16 year, payable in equal monthly installments from the general  
17 fund of the county and at that time, Section 1 shall become  
18 void. This salary shall be the total compensation of the  
19 coroner and shall be in lieu of any other compensation,  
20 salary, or expense allowance otherwise provided to the  
21 coroner.

22 Section 3. Effective on the expiration of the current  
23 term of the Coroner of Talladega County, Act 2001-491 of the  
24 2001 Regular Session (Acts 2001, p. 858) is repealed and any  
25 part of Act 2097 of the 1971 Regular Session (Acts 1971,  
26 p. 3364) providing for compensation to the coroner is repealed  
27 and superseded.

28 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
