25	Section 1. Section 40-10-16, Code of Alabama 1975,
26	is amended to read as follows:

"It shall be the duty of the tax collector, in making such sales, if practicable, to so offer such each parcel of real estate for sale that only such portion thereof may be sold as is necessary individually to satisfy the decree under which it each parcel is sold and the expenses of the sale of each parcel, to include the cost of advertising for each parcel, but no sale shall be made for a sum less than the amount of such decree and expenses."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
