26	Section 1. Section 17-3-8.1 is added to the Code of
27	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§17-3-8.1. 1 2 Upon receiving the written consent and approval of 3 the county commission and consistent with the annual maximum number of working days authorized under Section 17-3-8, a 4 quorum of a board of registrars of a county may reallocate 5 unused working days from one registrar due to absence to 6 another registrar of that board in order to accomplish the 7 public business of the board. 8

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the 11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
