## HB322 Enrolled

1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Calhoun County; to authorize the Calhoun  
3 County Commission to levy and provide for the collection of an  
4 additional vehicle license and registration fee on each  
5 vehicle license and registration, transfer, or renewal of any  
6 vehicle in the county; and to provide for distribution of the  
7 proceeds from the fees to the sheriff.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1.(a) The Calhoun County Commission may levy  
10 and provide for the collection of an annual additional motor  
11 vehicle license and registration issuance fee in the amount of  
12 up to two dollars (\$2) on each new registration, transfer, or  
13 renewal on any vehicle in the county commencing with the motor  
14 vehicle license and registration year commencing on January 1,  
15 2025, if levied prior thereto. If the county commission  
16 desires to levy the fee, the fee shall be levied prior to  
17 December 1, 2024. Thereafter, the county commission may not  
18 levy or amend or reduce the fee. The fee authorized by this  
19 section shall only be for one continuing annual two dollar  
20 (\$2) fee. The License Commissioner of the county or other  
21 license issuing officials shall collect the issuance fee on  
22 each new registration, transfer, or renewal on a vehicle in  
23 the county. The fee shall be in addition to all other fees,  
24 taxes, and other charges provided for the license and  
25 registration of a vehicle.

26 (b) The proceeds from the additional issuance fees upon  
27 collection shall be distributed on a monthly basis by the  
28 License Commissioner to the sheriff of the county to be

29 deposited in the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund to be used for  
30 law enforcement purposes.

31 (c) The proceeds from the fees and the use of the fees  
32 shall not diminish or take the place of any other source of  
33 funding of the sheriff's office.

34 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October  
35 1, 2024.
