2	church schools as defined in Section 16-28-1, shall carry out
3	a system of physical education, the character of which shall
4	conform to the program or course outlined by the Department of
5	Education and satisfy the requirements of this section.
6	"(b) Beginning with the 2011-12 school year, all
7	students in grades K-8 shall take physical education which may
8	include dance class if taught at a magnet school, marching
9	band, JROTC, or other activity as approved in the IEP of the
10	student."
11	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12	first day of the third month following its passage and
13	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
