University of South Alabama (USA) may participate in a meeting of the board or committee by means of telephone conference, video conference, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting for all purposes, including the establishment of a quorum. However, a majority of a quorum of the members of the board of trustees, or, in the event of a meeting of only the executive committee, a majority of a quorum of the executive committee of the board of trustees must be physically present at the location noticed and called for the meeting in order to conduct any business or

1	deliberation. Members of the board of trustees and any
2	committees of the board of trustees may not utilize electronic
3	communications except as in compliance with the Alabama Open
4	Meetings Act. Notice of USA board meetings shall be provided
5	in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and telephone
6	or video conference or similar communications equipment shall
7	also allow members of the public the opportunity to
8	simultaneously listen to or observe such meetings.
9	Section 2. This act shall become effective
10	immediately following its passage and approval by the
11	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
