To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during the 2009 Regular Session and Act 2009-814 of the 2009 First Special Session as contained in the 2009 Cumulative

Supplement to certain volumes of the code and 2009 Replacement Volume 15A; to initially adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, 2009 Volume 22E (Local Laws Conecuh - Cullman Counties) and to adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, 2009 Cumulative Supplements to local law volumes; to make hierarchy, formatting, and internal reference corrections to subdivision (21) of subsection (a) of Section 19-3B-816, found on page 386 of 2007 Replacement Volume 14, relating to specific powers of trustees under the Alabama Uniform Trust Code; and to specify that this adoption and incorporation constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire Code of Alabama 1975 and that this act is a law that adopts a code; to declare that the Code Publisher has certified it has discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes; to expressly provide that this act does not affect any other 2009 Special Session statutes or 2010 session statutes; and to specify the duties of the Secretary of State regarding the custody of these cumulative supplements, replacement volumes, and initial volume. Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during the 2009 Regular Session and Act 2009-814 of the 2009 First Special Session as contained in the 2009 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 15 inclusive, including the separate pamphlet to the supplement to Volume 7A containing Title 10A, and Volumes 16 to 22A inclusive, and the 2009 Replacement Volume 15A and the additions and deletions

made by the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published by West Group, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2009 Cumulative Supplement and 2009 Replacement Volume are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the cumulative supplement and upon the first inside page and the last inside page of the replacement volume, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

(b) The following correction is made:

Section 19-3B-816, 2007 Replacement Volume 14, page 386. In order to achieve appropriate hierarchy, formatting, and internal references, in subdivision (21) of subsection (a) after "(21)" insert (A). Designate existing paragraphs (A), (B), (C), and (D) as subparagraphs 1., 2., 3., and 4. In redesignated subparagraph 4., insert a period after "distribution" and delete "and". Redesignate the remaining language in 4. as (B) and in such language after "The trustee shall not be under any duty to see to the application of the payment" insert "made pursuant to subparagraphs 1. to 4. above,".

Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state previously enacted and contained in initial 2009 Volume 22E (Local Laws Conecuh - Cullman Counties) and the local and permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2009 Regular Session as contained in the 2009 Cumulative Supplement to Volumes 22B, 22C, and 22D and the additions and

1 deletions made by the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published by West Group, as the Code 2 Publisher, which volumes of the 2009 Cumulative Supplement are 3 identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of the volumes 5 6 of the cumulative supplement, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975.

Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the supplements, replacement volume, and initial volume specified in this act shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire Code of Alabama 1975 for purposes of Section 85 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. This act is a law that adopts a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended.

Section 4. It is declared that West Group, as the Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2009 Replacement Volume 15A of the Code of Alabama 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes with the material contained in the cumulative supplement without making substantive changes, but making, under the supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of names and titles

of governmental departments, agencies, and officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and misspellings.

Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute enacted into law during any 2009 Special Session, other than Act 2009-814, and any 2010 session of the Legislature.

Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, the duly authenticated volumes of the 2009 Cumulative

Supplements, the 2009 Replacement Volume, and the 2009 initial volume, shall be transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the volumes of the supplements, the replacement volume and the initial volume in that office. The volumes of the supplements, replacement volume, and initial volume shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for similar services.

Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
