8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Monroe
10 County, to provide for the judge of probate to be
11 compensated on a salary basis and for the fees
12 collected by the judge of probate to be deposited
13 in the county general fund; and to provide for the
14 one-stop issuance of motor vehicle license plates.

20 Relating to Monroe County; to propose an amendment
21 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide for the
22 judge of probate to be compensated on a salary basis and for
23 the fees collected by the judge of probate to be deposited in
24 the county general fund; and to provide for the one-stop
25 issuance of motor vehicle license plates.

26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 assessment and collection of ad valorem taxes on motor
2 vehicles, which have been performed by the revenue
3 commissioner prior to the effective date of this amendment.
4 The revenue commissioner is relieved of all duties and
5 responsibilities relating to the assessment and collection of
6 taxes on motor vehicles. The judge of probate shall receive
7 the commissions and fees currently allocated to the revenue
8 commissioner for performing these functions, and these fees
9 and commissions shall be deposited in the county general fund.
10 Reporting and remitting of the collections of these fees shall
11 be made by the judge of probate or as otherwise required by
12 law.

13 (e) This amendment, upon its ratification, shall
14 become effective the beginning of the next term of office of
15 the judge of probate in January 2019.

16 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
17 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01, now
18 appearing as Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Official
19 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
20 amended, and the election laws of this state.

21 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
22 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
23 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
24 following description of the substance or subject matter of
25 the proposed constitutional amendment:

26 "Relating to Monroe County, proposing an amendment
27 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide for the

1 judge of probate to be compensated on a salary basis and for
2 the fees collected by the judge of probate to be deposited in
3 the county general fund; and to provide for the one-stop
4 issuance of motor vehicle license plates.
