1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Perry County; to further provide for the
3 salary and expense allowance of the coroner; and to repeal
4 Section 45-53-60 of the Code of Alabama 1975, and Act 91-361
5 of the 1991 Regular Session (Acts 1991, p. 692), relating to
6 expense allowances of the coroner.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) Effective beginning June 1, 2024, the
9 Coroner of Perry County shall be entitled to receive an
10 expense allowance of twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) per
11 year, to be paid in equal monthly installments from the
12 general fund of the county. The expense allowance provided in
13 this section shall be in lieu of any other expense allowance
14 or fees currently provided to the coroner and shall be the
15 only expense allowance or fees provided to the coroner.

16 (b) Effective at the end of the term of the coroner
17 serving on June 1, 2024, this section shall be repealed.

18 Section 2. Effective beginning the next term of the
19 coroner, the coroner shall receive a salary of twelve thousand
20 dollars (\$12,000) per year, payable from the general fund of
21 the county in equal monthly installments. This salary shall be
22 the only compensation, expense allowance, salary, or fees
23 provided to the coroner.

24 Section 3. Effective June 1, 2024, Section 45-53-60 of
25 the Code of Alabama 1975, is repealed, and Act 91-361 of the
26 1991 Regular Session (Acts 1991, p. 692), superseded by
27 Section 45-53-60, is repealed.

28 Section 4. This act shall become effective on June 1,
