1 Enrolled, An Act,

2 Relating to Cullman County; to amend Section 1 of Act
3 2023-121 of the 2023 Regular Session, now appearing as Section
4 45-22-190, Code of Alabama 1975; to provide further for the
5 expenditure of monies from the Cullman County Legislative
6 Delegation Fund.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2023-191 of the 2023
9 Regular Session, now appearing as Section 45-22-190, Code of
10 Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

11 "§45-22-190

12 (a) The Cullman County Commission shall create the
13 Cullman County Legislative Delegation Fund.

14 (b) The fund shall be comprised of the following monies
15 received by the county:

16 (1) The additional three percent of TVA
17 in-lieu-of-taxes payments received pursuant to Section
18 40-28-2.

19 (2) The proceeds collected pursuant to Section 35-8B-5.

20 ~~(2)~~ (3) Any other monies provided for by law.

21 (c) The commission shall immediately pay amounts from
22 the fund as the Cullman County Legislative Delegation may
23 request.

24 (d) The legislative delegation shall expend the monies
25 on allowable public purposes at the discretion and direction
26 of the legislative delegation, based on the proportion of the
27 population each member of the delegation represents in the
28 county.

29 (e) All decisions concerning the Cullman County
30 Legislative Delegation Fund shall be made by resolutions
31 adopted by the members of the Cullman County Legislative
32 Delegation.

33 (f) Any funds allocated but not spent at the end of the
34 fiscal year shall not be applied for any other purpose, but
35 shall be carried forward and shall remain available year to
36 year for expenditure as provided in this section.

37 (g) The revenue and expenditures of the legislative
38 delegation office shall be audited on an annual basis."

39 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
40 2024.
