1 Enrolled, An Act,

2

3 To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year  
4 ending September 30, 2024, from the Opioid Treatment and  
5 Abatement Fund to the entities and for the purposes herein in  
6 the amount of \$30,000,000.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Opioid  
9 Treatment and Abatement Fund the sum of \$30,000,000 for the  
10 fiscal year ending September 30, 2024, to the entities and for  
11 the purposes specified herein:

12 (1) To the Department Corrections for an initiative to  
13 support the implementation or expansion of medication for  
14 opioid use disorders (MOUD)-Advancing Medication for Opioid  
15 Use Disorders in state prisons, \$1,000,000.

16 (2) To the Board of Pardons and Paroles, \$5,490,000. Of  
17 this amount, \$1,515,000 shall be used for substance abuse  
18 disorder (SUD) treatment and services for women; \$2,300,000  
19 shall be used for recovery and facility services, including  
20 housing and transitional space for those suffering from  
21 substance abuse disorder (SUD); \$175,000 shall be used to  
22 expand prevention services; and \$1,500,000 shall be used to  
23 implement a program to streamline navigation of services for  
24 people with or affected by substance abuse disorder (SUD).

25 (3) To the Department of Mental Health, \$20,510,000. Of  
26 this amount \$2,000,000 shall be used for Medicaid State Match;  
27 \$1,000,000 shall be used for residential detox; \$1,150,000  
28 shall be used for prevention and improved outcomes; \$3,000,000

29 shall be used for the 988 Crisis Line; \$8,060,000 shall be  
30 used for prevention, treatment, and recovery grants;  
31 \$1,300,000 shall be used for a statewide marketing campaign;  
32 \$1,000,000 shall be used for specialty courts; and \$3,000,000  
33 shall be used for a veterans pilot programs through an RFP  
34 process.

35 (4) To Auburn University College of Pharmacy for  
36 education and training related to substance abuse, \$1,000,000.

37 (5) To the University of Alabama at Birmingham for  
38 residencies in psychiatry related to the study and treatment  
39 of substance abuse, \$1,000,000. Of this amount, \$500,000 shall  
40 be used for a residency in Montgomery.

41 (6) To the Department of Public Health for purchase of  
42 Naloxone for distribution to state and local agencies and  
43 entities, \$1,000,000.

44 Section 2. All funds appropriated in this act not  
45 expended in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2024, shall  
46 not revert, but shall be carried forward for the purpose  
47 appropriated.

48 Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately  
49 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its  
50 otherwise becoming law.
