13 Relating to the City of Anniston in Calhoun County;
14 to amend Section 6.07 of Act 404 of the 1953 Regular Session
15 (Acts 1953, p. 472), now appearing as Section 45-8A-23.176 of
16 the Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the operation of the
17 council-manager form of government; to further provide for the
18 transfer of unencumbered appropriation balances.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Section 6.07 of Act 404 of the 1953
21 Regular Session (Acts 1953, p. 472), now appearing as Section
22 45-8A-23.176 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read
23 as follows:

24 "§45-8A-23.176.

25 "The city manager may at any time transfer any
26 unencumbered appropriation balance or portion thereof between
27 general classifications of expenditures within an office,

1 department, board, or agency, subject to ~~subdivision~~
2 paragraphs (a) to (j), inclusive, of ~~subsection~~ subdivision
3 (2) of Section 45-8A-23.091. ~~At the request of the city~~
4 ~~manager and within the last three months of the budget year,~~
5 ~~the~~ The council may by resolution transfer any unencumbered
6 appropriation balance or portion thereof from one office,
7 department, board, or agency, subject to ~~subdivisions~~
8 paragraphs (a) to (j), inclusive, of ~~subsection~~ subdivision
9 (2) of Section 45-8A-23.091. No transfer shall be made from
10 the appropriations fixed by law or required by subsections
11 (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), and (i) of Section
12 45-8A-23.144."

13 Section 2. This act shall become effective
14 immediately following its passage and approval by the
15 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
