9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
12

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines  
14 and corporate limits of the Town of Lexington in Lauderdale  
15 County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits  
18 of the Town of Lexington in Lauderdale County are altered,  
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate  
20 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now  
21 included, all of the following territory:

22 The South 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4; the South  
23 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 1  
24 South, Range 8 West, Lauderdale County, Alabama.

25 The NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 15, Township 1  
26 South, Range 8 West.

1           A part of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 15,  
2 Township 1 South, Range 8 West more particularly described as  
3 follows:

4           Begin at a point on the East line of said forty, 401  
5 feet, more or less, South of the Northeast corner thereof and  
6 at the Southeast corner of that tract conveyed to Lexington  
7 Fabrics, Inc. by deed recorded in the office of the Judge of  
8 Probate of Lauderdale County, Alabama on Fiche 86-200 Frame  
9 F009; continue thence South to the Southeast corner of said  
10 forty; run thence West 157 feet, more or less, to the  
11 centerline of a County Road; run then Northwardly along the  
12 centerline of said County Road to the Southwest corner of  
13 aforesaid Lexington Fabrics, Inc. tract; run thence east along  
14 the South line of said tract to the point of beginning.

15           Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of  
16 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is  
17 proposed to be annexed to the Town of Lexington is on file in  
18 the office of the Judge of Probate in Lauderdale County,  
19 Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

20           Section 3. This act shall become effective on the  
21 first day of the third month following its passage and  
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
