10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Macon County; to amend Section 2 of Act
14 93-875 of the 1993 First Special Session (Acts 1993 First
15 Special Session, p. 137), as last amended by Act 2008-463 of
16 the 2008 Regular Session (Acts 2008, p. 900), relating to the
17 Macon County Economic Development Authority; to provide for a
18 voting member of the board of directors to be appointed by
19 Tuskegee University.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. Section 2 of Act 93-875 of the 1993 First
22 Special Session (Acts 1993 First Special Session, p. 137), as
23 last amended by Act 2008-463 of the 2008 Regular Session (Acts
24 2008, p. 900), is amended to read as follows:

25 "Section 2. The authority shall be governed by a
26 board of directors consisting of members to be appointed as
27 follows: One member appointed by the Macon County Commission;

1 one member appointed by the member of the Alabama House of
2 Representatives who represents Macon County; one member
3 appointed by the member of the Alabama State Senate who
4 represents Macon County; one member appointed by Tuskegee
5 University; and one member appointed by the governing body of
6 each incorporated municipality in the county. The initial
7 terms of the directors shall be staggered. Two members, the
8 one appointed by the member of the House of Representatives
9 representing Macon County and the one appointed by the member
10 of the Alabama Senate representing Macon County, shall serve
11 for initial terms of two years and the remaining members shall
12 serve for initial terms of one year each. Notwithstanding the
13 foregoing, the initial member added to the board by
14 appointment of a municipality that did not appoint a member
15 prior to the effective date of the act adding this language
16 shall serve a term of four years and the initial member
17 appointed by Tuskegee University shall serve a term of four
18 years. Any member serving on the effective date of the act
19 adding this language, except the member previously appointed
20 by Tuskegee University, shall serve the remainder of his or
21 her term. Thereafter, all members shall serve for a term of
22 four years. All members shall serve until their successors are
23 appointed and qualified and no member shall serve for more
24 than two consecutive full terms. Upon a vacancy, the successor
25 shall be appointed in the same manner and by the same method
26 as the member whose place is being filled.

1 "Within 30 days after the effective date of this
2 act, the appointing authorities shall submit the names and
3 addresses of the members of the board to the judge of probate
4 and the appointments shall be filed and maintained in the
5 office of the judge of probate. The members shall elect from
6 among themselves a president, vice-president, secretary, and
7 treasurer. Each officer shall serve for a period of one year
8 or until a successor is elected to serve. No officer shall be
9 bonded, except the treasurer, who shall obtain bond as an
10 official.

11 "Ex officio nonvoting members of the board shall
12 consist of: One member from each industrial development board,
13 one member appointed by the Macon County Chamber of Commerce,
14 and one member from the Macon County Board of Education. The
15 board shall meet at least once per month."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
